



Sales Contract and Health Guarantee



This document constitutes an agreement between Texas Coastal Frenchies ("Seller") and _____ ("Buyer"). This is a private transaction between the Buyer and the Seller for the purchase of a _____. The following are the terms and conditions of this contract:

1. Price of the _____: (1) The Buyer agrees to the purchase of a _____ puppy for the amount of (USD) \$_____ to be paid to the Seller before this contract is effective. A non-refundable deposit of _____ with the reminder of balance due at pick-up or before shipping is to occur. Financial responsibility of the shipment of the animal is assumed by the Buyer.
 2. Identifying information for the puppy: (1) The Seller agrees to ship or deliver to the Buyer a _____ puppy with the following characteristics:

 3. Registration: (1) The Seller guarantees this animal to be registered or qualified for registration with the American Kennel Club.
 4. Health of the puppy: (1) The Seller agrees to deliver to the Buyer a _____ puppy with no symptoms of infectious or contagious disease or defects. The Seller certifies that the puppy has been vaccinated and de wormed to meet with veterinary standards and will come with a health record.
 5. Veterinary health certification: (1) The Seller guarantees that the puppy has been certified as healthy by a licensed veterinarian. (2) The Buyer agrees to pay for a licensed veterinary health examination within three days of taking possession the puppy. (3) The Buyer agrees to forward proof of veterinary appointment to the Seller. The terms and conditions of this contract are not effective until the Seller has acknowledged receiving this information. If the puppy is not given a clean bill of health, Seller must be notified immediately. Seller reserves the right to have the puppy re-examined by Seller's veterinarian at Seller's cost. Seller does not accept any results from any branch of Banfield clinic.
- The Buyer agrees to assume any financial responsibility for this examination, veterinary expenses and/or medications are not covered in this contract.
6. Health Warranty: (1) The warranty period for this puppy is one year from _____. This warranty covers fatal and life altering congenital diseases. This includes severe hip dysplasia as well as kidney, heart, pancreas, spine and liver problems of a severe, life threatening or altering nature. (2) If the puppy dies within this contract's effective period, the Buyer agrees to assume financial responsibility for an autopsy on the puppy, to be performed by a licensed veterinarian to determine the cause of death. (3) Buyer agrees to forward the written autopsy report to the Seller. (4) If the cause of death is found to be any affliction listed in the health warranty section of this contract, the Seller agrees to replace the puppy with one of similar identifying characteristics as those listed in the identifying information for the puppy section of this contract, unless characteristics are unavailable to the Seller or otherwise specified by the Buyer. (5) Buyer agrees that there is no monetary refund of any kind, full or partial guaranteed or implied. (6) The puppy must exhibit the congenital defect within the effective period of this contract. (7) The Buyer agrees to notify the Seller of the problem as well as furnish veterinary reports by two unassociated licensed veterinarians stating the affliction within two business days of the problem's discovery.
 7. Health conditions: (1) This guarantee does not apply to afflictions that are considered to be common in the bulldog breeds. These include, but are not limited to cherry eye, entropion, "loose" hips, skin allergies, elongated soft palate and collapsed nostrils, small trachea, hip dysplasia, stenotic nares (loud breathing or snuffled sounds when breathing) we cannot guarantee the puppy will not contract mange, (red mange, sarcoptic mange, demodex mange, ear mites or any mite mange). Skin allergies. Intestinal Parasites including coccidiosis, Giardia and worms. Kennel cough, pneumonia. Undescended testes. Luxated patella's grades 1-3. Food or skin allergies. Umbilical hernias (out facing belly button) are not covered.
 8. We are not responsible for any of the health conditions in future litters if the puppy is bred. Any kind of parasites, bacteria or viruses including parvo are only covered if contracted within 48 hours of purchase. Buyer understands that vaccination does not guarantee against these diseases. Environmental factors will not be covered by this guarantee. Including allergies, dysfunction and autoimmune disorders. The Seller does not assume responsibility for any reaction

to any vaccination. The Seller does not assume responsibility for any medical expenses incurred associated with any health problem. This guarantee does not apply to the presence of deafness or any kind of hearing problems. Please keep puppy away from any unhealthy pets or areas of possible infection. Seller does not assume responsibility for neglect or health problems relating from neglect. If a past puppy is found to be in a neglectful situation or has sustained any health problems resulting in injury, mistreatment or neglect, the Seller will go to the full extent of the law to have the puppy removed if Buyer refuses to return the puppy, in this case the Buyer agrees the Seller will retain ownership and may be financially responsible for the Sellers out of pocket expenses in recovering the puppy. In this situation the Seller assumes no financial responsibility and no refund will be forthcoming.

9. Puppy care: (1) The Buyer agrees to provide the puppy with routine preventative care and follow veterinarian guidelines for vaccination and deworming. (2) The Buyer agrees to keep the puppy away from dog parks, grassy areas, pet stores, etc. until the puppy is at least 16 weeks of age and has received final vaccination. (3) The Buyer agrees to keep the puppy away from lakes, rivers, oceans and other water with the puppy where the puppy can be in danger of drowning unless proper safety protocol is followed. (4) The Buyer agrees to provide adequate fresh water, quality food and rest to the puppy. (5) The Buyer assumes responsibility for protecting the puppy from loss, theft, danger, neglect and abuse.

9. Return policy. (1) A puppy eligible for replacement, pursuant to section 6 of this contract must be returned or euthanized with prior permission from the Seller to qualify for replacement. (2) The returned puppy must appear in good condition to the Seller, other than the specified problem. (3) A puppy will not be eligible for replacement if it has been or appears to have been neglected, abused, bred or euthanized without prior permission from the Seller. Buyer agrees to assume financial responsibility for all transportation costs incurred for transporting the returned puppy to the Seller.

10. Dispute: (1) This is the entire purchase contract; no other promise or stipulations are included or implied in this sale. (2) In any and all legal action pertaining to this dog, this contract shall be considered to be legally binding. (3) In the event of any dispute or disagreement under this contract, the laws of Texas will govern the resolution of the dispute. (4) To the extent that any provision of this contract may be invalid under any law of the state of the Buyer, all remaining provisions remain binding.
